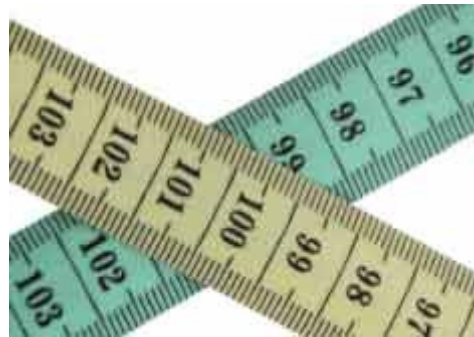
THE INTERNATIONAL EPD® SYSTEM

Version 3 of the General Programme Instructions has been published, setting a new set of rules for operation and management of the International EPD® System according to ISO 14025.

The update was made to stay relevant and up-to-date following developments in methodology, standardisation, research and applications of EPD.

Revised fees from January 2018

On January 1st 2018, the registration fee structure will be revised slightly to make it more simplified and to further encourage organisation to register more than one EPD.

The annual fees for 2018 will remain the same as previously. A separate registration fee will be introduced for registration of Sector EPDs, and the fee for the voluntary option of creating a climate declaration has been revised.
