European calculation rules (CEN PCR) for ceramics tiles adopted

A new product category-specific PCR standard, developed within CEN to complement the EN 15804 standard, has now been adoted via sub-PCRs in the International EPD® System: Sub-PCR-L Ceramic tiles (EN 17160)

The sub-PCRs does not add any additional methodological requirements, but simply refer


to the European standard. It is now available for any company wishing to declare an EPD for these product categories in the International EPD® System.
